Your child has been selected to participate in a mentoring initiative offered by Maury County Juvenile Court in collaboration with Reverend Jeff Kane from Westminister Presbyterian. The program is 10 weeks long and your child must attend all 10 sessions, only medical excuses will be accepted for absences. If your child is going to be absent you must call 931-375-1214 and inform Court Staff of this absence. Compass meets once per week on Tuesday evenings from 5:45-8pm, a meal is provided. You are responsible for transporting your child to and from this program; mentors are not allowed to provide any transportation. Failure to participate in this program will result in refiling of your child's case in Maury County Juvenile Court. We are very happy to provide this program to residents of Maury County and hope that it truly impacts your child. The following is very important information regarding this program, please read carefully:
